

Gene Full Name	ATM interactor
Function	Transcription factor. Plays a crucial role in cell survival and RAD51 foci formation in response to methylating DNA damage. Involved in regulating the activity of ATM in the absence of DNA damage. May play a role in stabilizing ATM. Binds to the DYNLL1 promoter and activates its transcription. [UniProt]
Calculated Mw	88 kDa
Cellular Localization	Nucleus. Nuclear, in discrete foci during G1 phase. [UniProt]
