cycles. Suggest spin the vial prior to opening. The antibody solution should be gently mixed before use.

Gene Full Name brain-derived neurotrophic factor

Background The protein encoded by this gene is a member of the nerve growth factor family. It is induced by

cortical neurons, and is necessary for survival of striatal neurons in the brain. Expression of this gene is reduced in both Alzheimer's and Huntington disease patients. This gene may play a role in the regulation of stress response and in the biology of mood disorders. Multiple transcript variants encoding distinct isoforms have been described for this gene. [provided by RefSeq, Jan 2009]

Function During development, promotes the survival and differentiation of selected neuronal populations of the

peripheral and central nervous systems. Participates in axonal growth, pathfinding and in the modulation of dendritic growth and morphology. Major regulator of synaptic transmission and plasticity at adult synapses in many regions of the CNS. The versatility of BDNF is emphasized by its contribution to a range of adaptive neuronal responses including long-term potentiation (LTP), long-term depression (LTD), certain forms of short-term synaptic plasticity, as well as homeostatic regulation

of intrinsic neuronal excitability. [UniProt]






ARG66957 anti-BDNF antibody IHC-Fr image

Immunofluorescence: HuVEC cells were fixed with 4% paraformaldehyde at RT for 10 min, permeabilized with 0.1% NP-40 at RT for 10 min and then cells were blocked with 5% BSA at RT for 30 min and stained with ARG66957 anti-BDNF antibody (red) at 1:200 dilution at 4°C for overnight. DAPI (blue) was used for nuclear staining.
