Gene Full Name cadherin 3, type 1, P-cadherin (placental)

Background This gene is a classical cadherin from the cadherin superfamily. The encoded protein is a calcium-

dependent cell-cell adhesion glycoprotein comprised of five extracellular cadherin repeats, a transmembrane region and a highly conserved cytoplasmic tail. This gene is located in a six-cadherin cluster in a region on the long arm of chromosome 16 that is involved in loss of heterozygosity events in breast and prostate cancer. In addition, aberrant expression of this protein is observed in cervical adenocarcinomas. Mutations in this gene have been associated with congential hypotrichosis with

juvenile macular dystrophy. [provided by RefSeq, Jul 2008]

Function Cadherins are calcium-dependent cell adhesion proteins. They preferentially interact with themselves

in a homophilic manner in connecting cells; cadherins may thus contribute to the sorting of


